

## **Committee for Parental Choice and Religious Freedom Contributor Fact Sheet**

### What is the Committee for Parental Choice and Religious Freedom (the “Committee”)?

It is a political committee set up to oppose a measure that will be on the November 2011 ballot which would ban circumcision in San Francisco, and which would subject doctors and mohels who perform those circumcisions to potential criminal prosecution.

### Are there limits on how much you may contribute to the Committee?

No. Contributions to ballot measure committees are unlimited as a matter of First Amendment law.

### Is your contribution to the Committee tax deductible?

No. Contributions to the Committee are not tax deductible as charitable contributions or business expenses.

Please also be aware that some tax professionals advise that contributions by individuals to ballot measures may trigger a federal “gift” tax. Individual contributors may wish to consult with a tax professional about this issue.

### Will your contribution be publicly disclosed by the Committee?

Yes. The Committee is legally required to publicly disclose all contributions of \$100 or more on reports filed with the San Francisco Ethics Commission, which are available on the Commission’s website.

### Will **you** be required to publicly disclose your contribution to the Committee?

Perhaps. Individuals and entities which contribute \$10,000 or more in a calendar year to all California state and/or local ballot measures, candidates, PACs and political parties combined must file their own campaign reports disclosing their contributions.

Also, a nonprofit organization will qualify as a PAC and have to file public reports potentially disclosing its donors, if it makes contributions to California state and/or local ballot measures, candidates, PACs, and political parties totaling \$1,000 or more on more than one occasion in a five year period.

How do you make a contribution?
